Mary Melnick is a pianist and composer that currently lives in Burlington, Vermont. This year she released an 82-minute musical piece dedicated to the two Italian men executed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on the electric chair in 1927. The name of the piece is “Sacco and Vanzetti, the Italian Years”. She will be performing this piece live for the first time in Boston at the Community Church of Boston.



When asked, “Why did you decide to compose a major musical piece in memory of the two executed men?
